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Synopsis of Part A Services (subject to available funds and level of need)

Case Management: Assist clients to enter/remain in care, apply for any 3rd party assistance such as Medicaid, Medicare, or ADAP.

Oral Health Care: General cleanings, fillings, dentures, crowns, periodontal cleanings (deep cleaning), partial teeth replacements, root canals, extractions.

Emergency Financial Assistance: Covers essential utilities and basic telephone service (not to exceed \$500/client/grant year), critical need items up to \$100 per request not to exceed \$300/client/grant year and emergency medications (not to exceed \$3,000/client/month).

Food Bank: Provide food and personal care items in a food bank setting. For persons at 200% FPL and below. **Home Delivered Meals:** Deliver meals to persons who are homebound.

Health Insurance: Provide assistance with premiums, co-pay and deductibles for medications, outpatient primary medical care, dental and vision insurance premium(s) for clients Cap of \$8,000 per client per funding year.

Housing Assistance: Provide short term, rental assistance not to exceed 2 months per client in a grant year.

Home Health Care: Provide medically related home care services.

Medical Nutrition Therapy: Provide nutritional education, counseling and nutritional supplements related to HIV disease progression and prevention.

Legal: Assist clients with legal matters such as documents relating to personal and estate planning, discriminations, notarial services, debtor problems, apply for benefits (public *i.e.* SSI, insurance and unemployment).

Medical Transportation: Provide public transit tokens and/or passes, gasoline vouchers, van and taxi services for HIV medically related appointments.

Medications: Antiretroviral, opportunistic infections and other HIV related medications. Cap of \$3,000/client/ month. Exceed cap application available.

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Mental Health Therapy: Intensive individual and family counseling services by state-qualified mental health professionals.

Primary Medical Care: Provide primary care visits with doctors or nurses and labs related to HIV.

Psychosocial Support: Provide individual and group support and counseling.

Substance Abuse- Outpatient: Provide ongoing substance abuse treatment and counseling for individual and/or groups by a state-licensed provider.

Referral for Health Care/Supportive Services: Assist clients with referrals for benefits and entitlement counseling. This includes assisting clients to apply for entitlement programs, health insurance or sessions to educate about health insurance.

Health Education/Risk Reduction: Provide individual and group education to individuals at risk of falling out of care on HIV and risks.

Centralized Linkage: Referral line for anyone (individual or agency) to call and refer individuals to care and services.

HIV at-home testing: program that provides free HIV-at home test kits. Process varies by agency.
